



Profile: Oregon's Anesthesiologist Workforce - 2012

Quick Facts

Between 2010 and 2012, the number of anesthesiologists identifying a practice address in Oregon dropped from 629 to 567, a 9.9% reduction.

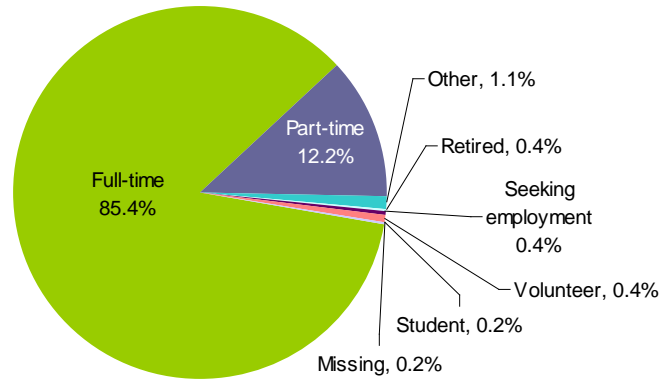
The statewide anesthesiologists-to-population ratio is 1:6,757. In 2010, that ratio was 1:6,079.

Sixty-one percent of Oregon's anesthesiologists identified their primary practice address within Multnomah County.

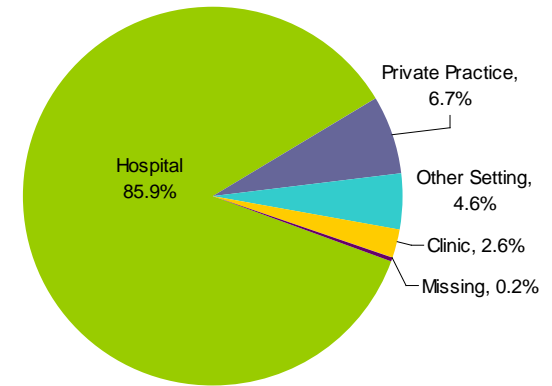
The average age of Oregon's anesthesiologists is 49.5. Thirty-four percent of Oregon's anesthesiologists are 55 years of age and older.

The percentage of female anesthesiologists rose from 23.8% in 2010 to 26.8% in 2012.

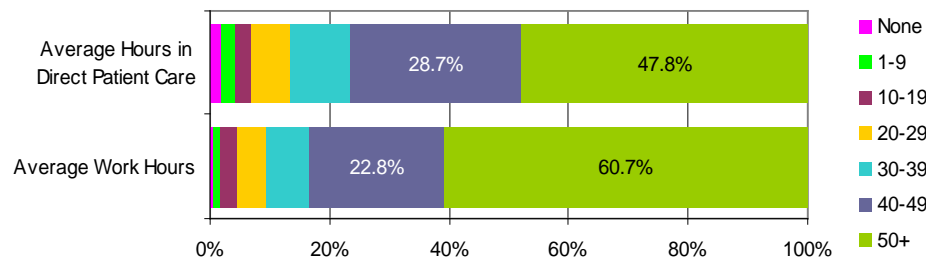
Employment Status



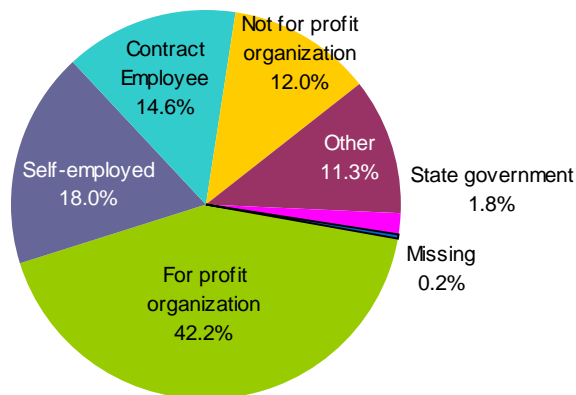
Work Setting



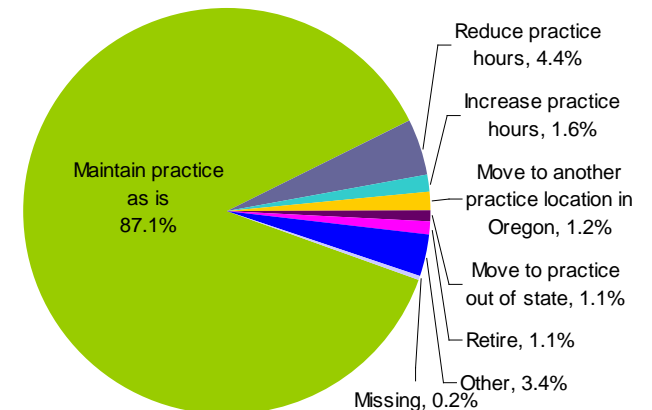
Average Work and Direct Patient Care Hours



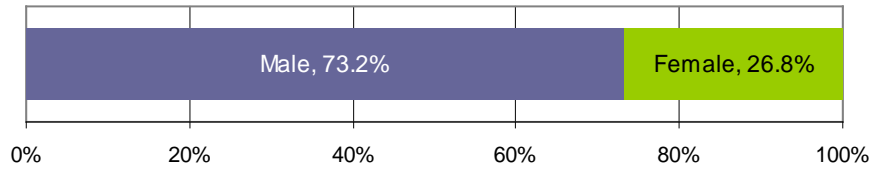
Form of Employment



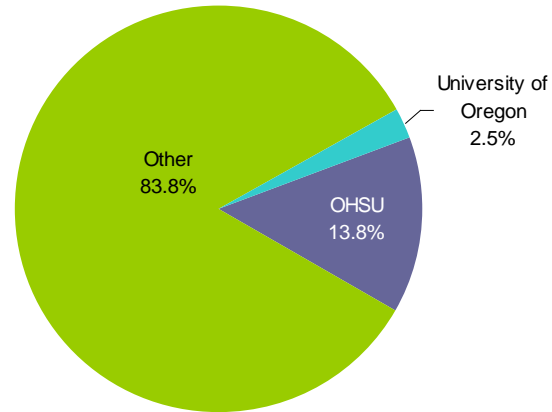
Future Practice Plans



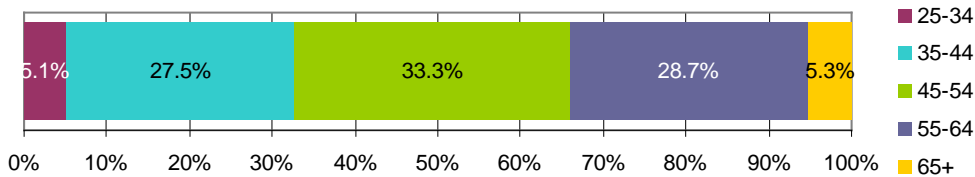

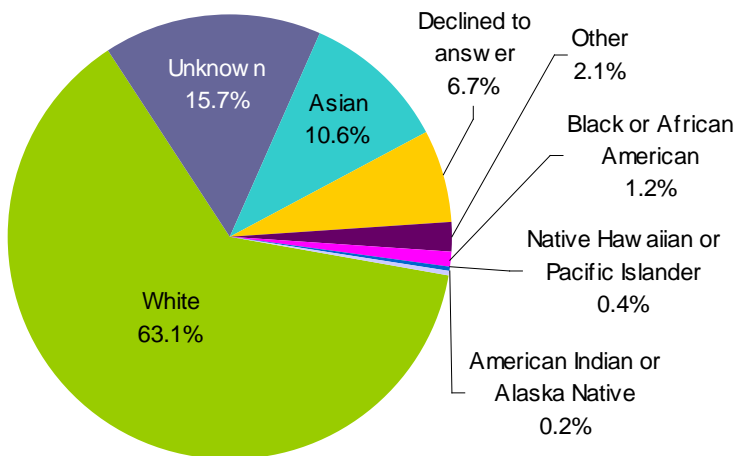

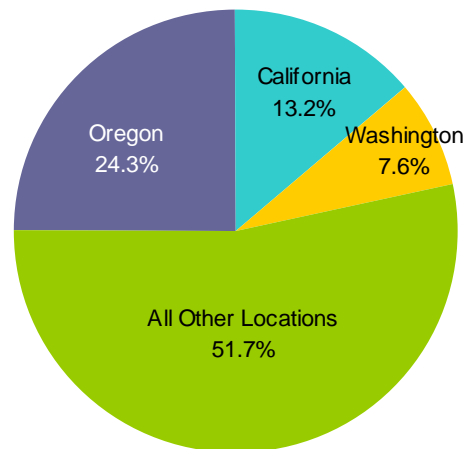
